

RESTAURANT RESIDENCY & INCUBATOR

Located within our headquarters in downtown Chattanooga, TN at 422 E. MLK Blvd. Proofs flagship space includes a Restaurant Residency & Kitchen Incubator program which to date has provided space, support, and employment opportunities for dozens of local enterprises.

The Restaurant Residency program is designed to give training, resources, and a turnkey restaurant to startup food and beverage entrepreneurs in order to demonstrate proof of concept, test and refine product-market fit, and help them increase their network and access to capital so they can launch and thrive in their own restaurant space in the future.

that are actively launching or scaling operations. Eligible businesses must be food & beverage related-included restaurants, breweries, pop-ups, as well as consumable food/drink based packaged goods, etc. The educational and technical assistance resources will be transmitted in a hybrid of both in-person and remote.






